Help Needed	Macauley has Autistic Spectrum Disorder and a moderate learning disability, he is unable to be left unsupervised as he has no awareness of danger. Currently Macauley has a softplay style bed and is in the process of having sot padding installed on his bedroom door as he kicks it. The family are currently using a high stair gate to keep Macauley safe in the living area and prevent him accessing the front door and stairs however Macauley violently kicks this and shakes it, it has now bent the bars and there is a concern Macauley can cause harm by kicking the bars. The family would benefit from a high, sturdy gate being installed to keep Macauley safe.
Disability Details	Macauley has autism and a moderate learning delay, he is unsteady on his feet and has no awareness of danger. This means he requires constant supervision. Macauley is always trying to escape which causes him to violently kick doors to try and get out of them, this is causing the family distress as they fear for his safety
