Help Needed	<p>Sue had a hypoxic brain injury caused by a cardiac arrest in 2018. She is reliant on her daughter (Shelley) and carers for all her care needs. She spends most of her time in bed. The only time she gets out of bed is when she is hoisted onto the commode/shower chair. Shelley mentioned that it is very difficult to wash Sue's hair - she has very limited muscle activity and her neck is very stiff and flexed forwards.
